

## Woodstock Festival Costs Bethel Official His Post

BETHEL, N. Y., Nov. 5 (AP) —The Democratic Supervisor of the Town of Bethel lost a re-election bid by eight votes yesterday after a campaign with one issue—the massive rock music festival last summer.

Daniel Amatucci had permitted the Woodstock Music and Art Festival to be held in Bethel. About 300,000 young people descended on the tiny Catskill Mountain community.

Mr. Amatucci lost 598 to 590.

The victory of his opponent, Republican George Neuhaus, who was critical of the festival, gave Republicans solid control of the Sullivan County Board of Supervisors by a weighted-vote margin of 373 to 324.
